

Dear Students and Parents,

In addition to being in a large ensemble, each EYSO student has the opportunity to participate in a chamber music group. This essential part of the development of a young musician helps to teach skills that improve both solo and large ensemble playing. Each player is both a soloist and team member at the same time. Playing chamber music sharpens vital listening skills and provides invaluable musicianship training. In fact, students who play in chamber ensembles typically improve faster than those who don't. There is a wealth of fantastic and significant chamber music repertoire and joining the CMI is a great way to begin learning it.

Typically, about a third of the EYSO members are enrolled in the Chamber Music Institute. Each ensemble meets for an hour every Sunday and has a regular coach. Our coaches are some of the most gifted educators and performers in the Chicago area and have a great passion for teaching. The semester ends with a series of concerts. In addition to the two main concerts in the fall and in the spring, CMI groups are also invited to perform at several community concerts throughout the area.

We will do our best to place each student who applies, but may be limited by the number of applicants and the instruments they play. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact me.

WHAT YOU'LL GET

Each chamber ensemble will be assigned their own coach with whom they'll work for the entire semester. Coaches are Chicago area professionals. Coachings take place on Sunday afternoons/evenings at Elgin Community College.

Each semester you'll receive 7 coachings and other opportunities for rehearsals, master classes and/or performances.

Classes will involve discussions of chamber music, listening, music history, theory, analysis, and, of course, playing for each other!

Every group will perform one or more selections on each semester's chamber music concert:

1st semester concerts: November 20, 2011

2nd semester concerts: April 22, 2012

There will be additional performing opportunities during and before EYSO concerts, as well as in the Fox Valley area.

1st semester coachings begin September 18, 2011.

2nd semester coachings begin January 15, 2012.
