Attendance Policies (from Season Handbook)

The most valuable contribution musicians can make to their ensemble is their presence at rehearsal, and attendance is taken at every rehearsal and event. Membership in the EYSO is a commitment to faithful, consistent, and punctual attendance. It is expected that rehearsals will be a high priority in each musician's life since each musician is holding a valuable place in their ensemble.

TARDINESS

Because of limited rehearsal time, starting promptly is very important. Musicians should arrive at least 15 minutes before their rehearsal start time to check in and unpack. Late arrival to rehearsal (arriving to the rehearsal room after the orchestra has tuned) is considered as missing half a rehearsal.

COME ANYWAY

In instances when musicians are physically unable to play their instruments, they should still attend rehearsal, sit with their colleagues, and actively participate in rehearsal.

ABSENCES

All musicians are expected to prioritize Sunday rehearsals. Membership in EYSO requires commitment to faithful, consistent, and punctual attendance, and that absences should be taken only when unavoidable. **Musicians who miss more than two rehearsals (including any dress rehearsal or Fall Camp absences) in a concert cycle will not be permitted to play in the performance.** Late arrivals to or early departures from rehearsal are considered as missing half a rehearsal.

FALL CAMP ATTENDANCE

Attendance at Fall Camp is required, since the work of several regular rehearsals is accomplished in a very concentrated time period. This year, the Saturday of Fall Camp is an SAT test date. If your orchestra attends Fall Camp on Saturday (PH, YS), please schedule your SAT on a different date.

Arriving late to Fall Camp counts as missing half a rehearsal. Missing one day of Fall Camp counts as one absence. Missing two days (applies to PH or YS only) counts as two absences. Absences from Fall Camp are considered part of the November concert cycle.

ATTENDANCE COMMMUNICATION

All planned absences (including dress rehearsals) must be communicated at the beginning of each concert cycle. Review the EYSO calendar carefully along with all your other commitments, then use the "Report an Absence" form on your Member Page to report any anticipated absences, late arrivals, or early departures by the deadline:

- For the November concert cycle (September 7 November 16), report by September 5, 2025.
- For the March concert cycle (January 4 March 8), report by January 2, 2026.
- For the May concert cycle (March 15 May 10), report by March 13, 2026.

For last-minute emergencies or conflicts that arise after the reporting deadline, musicians must call the EYSO office at 847-841-7700, extension 1, to explain (leave a voicemail if need be).

DRESS REHEARSALS

Dress rehearsals are typically scheduled for the Friday or Saturday before each concert, and dates are listed on the Season Calendar. Exact times are determined approximately 6 weeks before each concert and are shared in weekly eNews and conductor emails. Dress rehearsals are required. To be eligible to play the concert, a musician must attend their ensemble's entire dress rehearsal. The only exceptions are for school music performances, serious illness/injury, a family wedding, a funeral/death in the family, or religious observances.

Anticipated dress rehearsal absences must be communicated at the beginning of the concert cycle along with regular rehearsal absences. Musicians who miss the dress rehearsal for an excused reason may be asked to submit additional playing check-ins to ensure performance readiness, and/or seating may be adjusted at the discretion of the conductor.
