



EYSO SUMMER CHAMBER MUSIC CAMP 2020 INFORMATION

Health Protocol Summary

Please review these health protocols to ensure that we have a safe and healthy summer.

We ask that parents and students read and discuss this material in advance. These policies have been designed to meet or exceed state guidelines, and as such we must take compliance very seriously. All students and parents must follow the protocols below and related directions from staff.

- The camp will be organized into “units” of 10 people, including 2 staff and 8 students (i.e. two chamber ensembles). These units will be static and will have designated rooms and schedules to ensure distancing from the other units. Activity with more than one unit will take place outdoors with minimum 30 feet of distance.
- Staff and students will be required to wear masks over nose and mouth when indoors (possible exceptions for medical reasons should be discussed before camp) and keep 6 feet of distance. When outdoors, masks are not required, but 6 foot distancing must be maintained.
- Students and staff must self-check for symptoms including cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, fever of 100.4 degrees or above or other CDC-defined symptoms. Students or staff experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- Water fountains will be disabled, but some touch-free water bottle refilling stations will be available, in addition to bottled water.
- Please keep your personal belongings isolated in the area directed by your TA.
- Please see the “Drop-off and Pick-up procedure” section for arrival and departure details. Elgin Academy will not provide after-hours care this year, so we will require drop-off and pick-up within designated time windows.
- Daily temperature and symptom check for students and staff via touchless thermometer upon arrival.
- Lunches should be brought from home in single-use containers and disposed of after each meal. EYSO will supply a light snack in the afternoon.
- Elgin Academy will be cleaning the facility nightly, and EYSO staff will disinfect high touch surfaces throughout the day.
- Hand washing or sanitizing will be encouraged at regular intervals throughout the day.
