**Hayao Miyazaki** (b. 1941) is a renowned Japanese animator. He co-founded Studio Ghibli and helped animate and produce movies such as *Spirited Away*, *My Neighbor Totoro*, and *Howl's Moving Castle*.

**Joan Mitchell** (1925-1992) was inspired by Henri Matisse to create gorgeous and intense paintings. She mainly produced abstract expressionist art using pastels. Born in the US, she lived in France for most of her career, and her art can be found in both countries.

**Antoni Tudisco** (b. 1991) is a contemporary CGI artist. His works are clearly recognizable by their brightly colored 3D effects. This German artist has worked with big names such as Will Smith and Pop Smoke. You can find his works on his many social media platforms.

**Robert Capa** (1913-1954) was a Hungarian-American war photojournalist. Many consider him to be the best combat photographer in history. He is recorded as the only civilian photographer to land on Omaha Beach on D-Day. His photos can be found in many art galleries in America and Europe.

**Georgia O'Keeffe** (1887-1986) was a modernist painter who painted for seven decades. She is known for her beautiful watercolors, charcoal drawings, and abstract art. The art she produced ranges from New York skyscrapers to traditional Hawaiian fishhooks. Her artwork can be found all around the world, notably at the Art Institute of Chicago.

**Dondi White** (1961-1998) Better known as "DONDI," was a graffiti artist from East New York. He has worked on both canvas and walls, known for his dynamic lettering and stick figures. Works by Dondi can be found in many places around the world, like New York, the Netherlands, and France.
